

## **INTRODUCTION**

THE THOKCHOM IBOTOMBI INSTITUTE OF TEACHER EDUCATION AND TRAINING, BISHNUPUR was established on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 1997 and registered in the same the year under the Manipur Societies registration act, 1989 (Act No. 1 of 1990). Its registration number is 40 of 1997. The college is situated at Bishnupur Ward No.7 about one-half Km from the heart of Bishnupur Bazar. The college land pucca building was donated by Smt. Thokchom Ongbi Dashumati Devi in the name of her husband Late Shri Thokchom Ibotombi Singh. The college is called Thokchom Ibotombi Institute of Teacher Education and Training (TIITET), Bishnupur as a mark of gratitude to him. Late Shri Thokchom Ibotombi Singh was born on 12<sup>th</sup> February, 1912 at Khoijuman Maning Leikai, Bishnupur District and passed away on 5<sup>th</sup> June, 1990. The college has acquired land for setting up the teacher educational institution and spacious campus with playground for games and sports and has also adequate land of hostel facilities for boys and girls. The college is concerned with 13 High and Higher Secondary Schools recognized by the Board of Secondary Education Manipur (BOSEM) for Practice Teaching and Demonstration. The college is run and managed by the Governing Body on “No profit and No loss” basis without any financial assistance from funding agency or the Government of Manipur. The college is a co-educational institution.

## **LOCATION**

The Thokchom Ibotombi Institute of Teacher Education and Training (TIITET), Bishnupur is located at the eastern side of the Bishnupur Ward No. 7 (Khoijuman Road) at a distance of about half Km. from the heart of the Bishnupur Bazar. The institution is ideally located for the student to arrive either by or by auto from any part of Bishnupur District. Students arriving for

the first time at Bishnupur by bus may hire an auto and proceed to college. The auto fare may be Rs 5/- or Rs 10/- only. The college is free from noise and pollution. It is ideal place of solidarity for study.

### **AIMS AND OBJECTS**

THE AIMS AND OBJECTS FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF THE INSTITUTION ARE:

- I. To impart teachers training to all untrained teachers and qualified graduates/post-graduates of Manipur in particular and from other State of India in general.
- II. To facilitate all sections of the societies in moulding the career of the young and future generation of the society.
- III. To promote awareness and understanding among the youths and teachers by giving the facilitated of teaching in the teaching profession.
- IV. To enhance the standard of education in all educational institutions by imparting greater and proper guidance and training to the untrained teachers for future generations.
- V. To organize seminars and provide facilities of interchanging views and opinions by way of inviting visitors, lecturers and resource persons from different departments and colleges.
- VI. To provide facilities to the poor and needy people of Manipur. The rural and urban people who are financially backward i.e. Schedule Tribes/Schedule Castes and Other Backward Classes will be facilitated.
- VII. To give scholarship for studentship, prizes and financial assistance to the poor and needy trainees to encourage for further studies.
- VIII. To maintain the standard of the institute/college upto the status of other institutions/colleges in collaboration with NCTE/Manipur University

and Government of Manipur to promote the standard of education in its true sense and meaning of education.

### **RECOGNITION**

In exercise of the power vested under section 14 (3) (a) of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) Act 1993. The Eastern Regional Committee granted Recognition to Thokchom Ibotombi Institute of Teacher Education and Training, Bishnupur, P/O Bishnupur for B.Ed course from the session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 60 (Sixty) students capacity and now increased upto 100 students Vide Order No. ERC/&-40 (ER-40.6.2/2003/341 (1), dated the 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2003.

### **AFFILIATION**

The Thokchom Ibotombi Institute of Teacher Education and Training(TIITET), Bishnupur has obtained permission from the Manipur University Vide Order No. 3/3-840/98-EDC 17/04/98 and it is affiliated to the Manipur University Vide Order No. MU/1-66/98/EDC/1869, dated the 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2004.

### **DURATION AND INTAKE**

- a) The B.Ed programme shall be of duration of two academic years as per NCTE norms and standard, which can be completed in a maximum of three years from the date of admission to the programme.
- b) There shall be two units (50 students for each unit) only for an academic year.

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION**

- a) Candidates with at least 50% mark either in the Bachelor's Degree/Master's Degree in sciences/social sciences/Humanity.

- b) Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or Technology with specialization in science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto is eligible for admission to the programme.
- c) Admission should be made either on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination or in the entrance test examination conducted by the University or any recognized University of India or Selection Committee.
- d) There shall be reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/Handicapped/Women etc. as per rules of the State Government.

### **APPLICATION FORM AND PROSPECTUS**

Prescribed Application form along with the prospectus can be had from the college office on payment of Rs 500/- (it may be revised from time to time).

### **ENCLOSURES (TO BE SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION FORM)**

Dully filled in application form with the following documents should reach to the office on or before the date given/fixed by the college authority.

- a) Attested copy of provisional certificates and mark sheets from the HSLC examination onwards/qualifying examination.
- b) Three copies of recent passport size photograph.
- c) For SC/ST/OBC candidates, the caste/tribe certificate issued by the competent authority.
- d) For physically handicapped candidates, a certificate from a Doctor of the Civil Hospital showing the nature of handicap and also to the effect that such disability will not hamper in pursuing the course of study.



N.B. Incomplete application form submitted after the last date shall not be accepted/entertained.

### **COLLEGE FEE AND PAYMENT**

The selected candidates/students should deposit the admission fee to the Manipur State Co-Operative Bank Ltd., Bishnupur or UCO Bank, Bishnupur through challan issued/supplied by the college. The candidates/students should return the challan copy to the college after depositing the amount.

N.B.

- a) Tuition fee for twelve (12) calendar months shall be paid through a scheduled bank at one time.
- b) Any kind of fees once paid will not be refunded/adjusted in relation to college matter.

### **EXAMINATION**

Final Tentative Examination programme shall be fixed/made by the University from time to time. The college shall conduct a Pre-Final/Internal Examination before the final theory examination. Anybody who fails to appear the said examination shall not be sent up his or her names to the University.

### **LABORATORIES**

- a. The college has well equipped laboratories for Physical, chemistry and Biological for conducting practical classes.
- b. The college has well equipped psychology laboratories and Geography laboratories etc.

### **LIBRARY**

The college has a well stocked library contained Reference books, Encyclopedia books, Text books, Magazine, Journal, Periodical magazine, Newspapers etc. The following rules should be observed by the students:

1. The student of the college shall be membership of the library.
2. Strict discipline and silence are to be observed in the library and reading room.
3. Card holder students are allowed only to borrow one book at a time for two days.
4. Any defect of the book like missing of pages, deformation etc. Should be checked and reported to the Librarian at the issuing of book.
5. Books should not be retained more than 5 days from the date of issue of the book.

### **HOSTEL FACILITIES**

Hostel facilities for both male and female are available inside the college campus.

### **EDUCATIONAL STUDY TOUR**

The college shall organize an Educational Study Tour (Internal Excursion) regularly likely in the month of September or October of every academic session and its expenditures shall also borne by the trainees.

### **ATTENDANCE**

Students are required to attend classes regularly and in time:

- a) The minimum attendance is required 80% of the lectures delivered including practical.
- b) Attendance of 60% above and less than 80% of the lectures delivered is liable to pay non-collegiate fee for appearing at the B.Ed Final Examination.
- c) Attendance of lectures delivered below 60% is not permissible for appearing at the B.Ed Final Examination (Dis-Collegiate).

N.B. The dis-collegiate students are not permitted to appear at the B.Ed Final Examination as per rules and regulations of the Manipur University Examination.

### **EDUCATIONAL TECHNOLOGY**

#### **The Teaching Aids:**

Video Camera, Audio Tapes, Over Head Projector, Slide Projector, Radio, Memory, Drum and Mirror Apparatus etc. are available.

### **GAMES AND SPORTS**

The students can avail of the facilities of taking part in the college Annual Sports Meet and other sports events of the state. It will be held every year in the month of September/October.
